Native American Flip Book Project Guidelines

These are the sections of the Flipbook and what should be included in each section. This project will be completed mostly in class in partners or small groups. Each person will turn in their own Flipbook for an INDIVIDUAL grade.

Clothing

- a picture or drawing of the clothing the members of this group wore
- a description of the clothing the members of this group wore
- Did they have any clothing for special occasions or celebrations? If so, include a picture or drawing and a description.

<u>Housing</u>

- a picture or drawing of the type of housing this group lived in
- a description of the housing
 - What was the housing made from?
 - Why did they use those materials?

Food Sources

- the major food sources for this group
 - What types of plants did this group eat?
 - What types of animals did they eat? Did they hunt and fish?
- include pictures or drawings of the major foods

Location

- a map showing where the group lived (a picture or drawing)
- label the exact location
- description of why the group chose this location

<u>Culture</u>

- Provide a summary of the group's way of life that may include:
 - o celebrations
 - o beliefs
 - \circ education
 - \circ artwork
 - o other interesting facts
